



19 U.S. AIRMEN KILLED IN KHOBAR TOWERS BOMBING

JUNE 25, 1996, SAUDI ARABIA

A terrorist attack on part of a housing complex in the city of Khobar, Saudi Arabia, the Khobar Towers bombing was initially blamed on Hezbollah Al-Hejaz. In a press conference in Washington, DC on April16, 1997, the National Council of Resistance of Iran (NCRI) revealed that the truck bombing was ordered and planned by the Iranian regime's Islamic Revolutionary Guards Corps-Qods Force (IRGC-QF).

More than 19 years after the Saudi Hezbollah detonated a 25,000 pound TNT bomb that killed 19 U.S. airmen at Khobar Towers in Saudi Arabia, the pan-Arab daily Asharq al-Awsat said on Wednesday that Riyadh had apprehended Ahmed al-Mughassil, a key terrorist linked to the attack. But who is the real mastermind behind the deadly terrorist attack?

According to the NCRI information, the Qods Force's 6th Corps that is responsible for carrying out terrorist and subversive

operations in the Persian Gulf region carried out the operation. IRGC

GENERAL AHMAD SHARIF

the commander of the Qods Force 6th Corps directly oversaw the operation. Sharifi's immediate



superior was IRGC Brig. Gen. Ahmad Vahidi, commander of the Qods Force at the time. Vahidi was later appointed as Defense Minister. In 2006, a U.S. court found Iran and Hezbollah guilty of orchestrating the attack

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


Excerpt:

ARGENTINA BOMBING

Iranian President "HASSAN ROUHANI was on the pecial Iranian government committee that plotted the 1994 ombing of a Jewish community center in Buenos Aires... According to a 2006 indictment, the decision to launch the attack in Argentina was made within a special operations committee connected to the powerful Supreme National Security Council in August 1993. According to the indictment, Supreme Leader ALI KHAMANE led the special committee, and Khamenei and RAFSANJANI made the ultimate decision to go ahead with the attack.

Argentina has accused the Iranian government of directing the bombing, which killed 85 and injured 300, and the Lebanon-based terror group Hezbollah of carrying it out. ...



Six Iranians have been on Interpol's most wanted list since 2007 in connection with the bombing, including the current defense minister, GEN. AHMED VAHIDI ".






